

Purchasing a “Hoosier Family of Readers” license plate supports your schools. Nearly \$19 of the specialty plate’s cost is sent to BCEF by the county auditor. In turn, the foundation uses those funds for innovative programs that enhance learning for all students in the district.

Here's how the education license plate benefits BCEF and students:

Plates cost \$40 each
\$15 goes toward administrative costs
\$18.75 goes to BCEF
\$6.25 goes to the Indiana Department of Education to support elementary counseling programs

How to Purchase a Plate: Receive an Education Specialty Plate on a License Plate Renewal:

- Go to the Indiana BMV website at <http://www.in.gov/bmv/> and log into your BMV account to pull up your vehicle registration.
- Click on “Change My Plate.”
- In the Category field, choose “Special Organizations.”
- In the Specific Plate field, choose “Education.”
- Select your county of residence and Batesville Community Schools as your district to receive proceeds from your purchase.
- Continue your license plate renewal as usual.

Renew Your Current Education Specialty Plate:

- Go to the Indiana BMV website at <http://www.in.gov/bmv/> and log into your account to pull up your vehicle registration.
- Renew normally, and it renews your commitment to education.

Get an Education Specialty Plate for a New Vehicle:

- Go to the Indiana BMV website at <http://www.in.gov/bmv/> and click on “Register a New Vehicle Online.” Log into your account.
- In the purchasing process, you should select the following:
 - In the Category field, choose “Special Organizations.”
 - In the Specific Plate field, choose “Education.”
 - Select your county of residence and Batesville Community Schools to receive proceeds from your purchase.
- Continue your license plate purchase as usual.
