BEYOND THE BASICS

Instructions for Applying for BCEF Scholarships

The number of scholarships and the amount of money distributed may vary from year to year.

*NOTE: According to BCEF rules, **the following family members** of current BCEF board members/staff/ BCEF scholarship selection committee **are ineligible** to receive any of these scholarships: spouses, siblings, children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren; and spouses thereof (if applicable.)*

NOTE: Any BCEF scholarship recipient who receives total scholarships from all sources in excess of the total cost of attendance for their selected college must immediately notify BCEF so that an alternate recipient may be selected.

Read instructions carefully. Applications that are incomplete in any way will not be considered. This includes missing signatures.

1. Determine which scholarship(s) you would like to apply for. Criteria for each scholarship are included on the application cover page.
2. Download and save the BCEF Common Scholarship Application to your computer and complete using the fillable form.
3. Be sure to sign the application, sign the photo release and the acknowledgment about the BHS Student Code of Conduct, and if you are under 18, also have your parent/guardian sign. Application is INCOMPLETE without signatures.
4. Include in each application packet:
 - a. Cover page, with the name of the scholarship for which you are applying checked;
 - b. A copy of the application;
 - c. High school transcript;
 - d. Copy of FAFSA Submission Summary page with Student Aid Index (this page only, do not need entire FAFSA form). This is required for college-bound students but optional for trade school applicants; and
 - e. Any supplemental information required for a particular scholarship (i.e. essay or other information requested in application).
5. Submit a separate **single-sided, unstapled paper copy** of the packet **for each scholarship to:**
Batesville Community Education Foundation, P.O. Box 121, Batesville, IN 47006. Packet may also be dropped off at the BCSC Administration Building, clearly labeled "BCEF Scholarship Application."
6. After submission of application, email a photo of yourself to info@BatesvilleEducationFoundation.org with "Photo for BCEF scholarship app" and your name in subject line.
7. Scholarship applications are due no later than 4:00 PM on February 28, 2025. Late applications will not be accepted.

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A copy of this cover page must accompany **each** scholarship application. Please indicate on the cover page which scholarship you are applying for. If applying for more than one scholarship, you must make **additional copies of the application and cover page for each**.

James E. Fritsch Memorial Scholarship

- Applicants must be BHS graduating students in the top 20% of the class.
- Five \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded in 2025.

Randy Smith Scholarship

- Applicants must be BHS graduating students in the top 20% of the class. While NOT REQUIRED, special consideration will be given to first-generation college students.
- One \$5,000 one-time scholarship will be awarded and one \$5,000 scholarship, RENEWABLE for up to three additional years with verified cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or greater, will also be awarded.

Mary C. Horstman Memorial Scholarship

- All BHS graduating students who are pursuing additional education of any kind after graduation are encouraged to apply.
- While NOT REQUIRED, if there are any applicants with a direct connection to agriculture (through a family farm, FFA membership, or future field of study) OR who are continuing their education in a trade after high school graduation, their applications will receive special consideration. However, they are NOT guaranteed selection.
- Three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in 2025.

Bobbie Brandes Memorial Scholarship

- Applicants must be BHS graduating students in the top 20% of the class.
- Though NOT REQUIRED, the following will be taken into consideration:
 - 1st generation college-bound
 - Demonstrated leadership in school organizations or sports teams
 - Planning to pursue a career in education
 - Civic and community engagement
- One \$3,000 scholarship will be awarded in 2025.

Ron Raver Memorial Scholarship

- Applicants must be BHS graduating students in the top 20% of the class AND have participated in cross country, basketball, or track during high school.
- In addition, applicants should be able to demonstrate that they have the following qualities and characteristics that Coach Raver displayed:
 - Actively involved in school, church, and community
 - Proven determination and perseverance
- One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded in 2025.

Scholarships recipients will be notified privately prior to the May 1 college choice deadline and announced at Senior Night.
